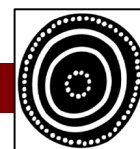

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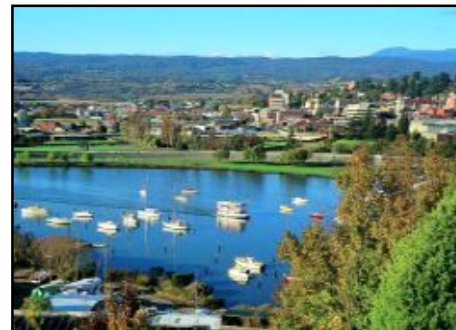
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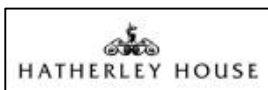
DAY 01 Board your international flight in Los Angeles. Fly to Australia. Relax, mate—it's a night flight!

Cataract Gorge is lovely...With steep walls along the banks of the South Esk River as it enters the Tamar, the Gorge boasts towering dolerite facades, walking tracks, lookouts, a suspension bridge, Victorian gardens, and for the adventurous, the longest single span chairlift in the world.

DAY 04 Full Tassie breakfast.
Change states today, but first...
Transfer to Bridport. Travel through scenic countryside, past several of Tasmania's most famous vineyards.



Golf: Barnbougale Dunes.
Since opening in 2004, the Tom Doak—Mike Clayton designed course has racked up numerous honors. Built on the Bass Strait shore, the dunes roll down to tidal flats and farmland. The links plays 6,755 yards long and is ranked 49th in the world.

The 16th green's gentle 150-yard par-3 appears benign, but first you must negotiate the mound on the right. This is actually an 18' deep bunker. Beware.



No golf? No problem. East coast flightseeing.
Freycinet National Park is a do-not-miss ribbon of dramatic landscape, ecology and wildlife. Or...take to the gourmand's track: fresh local produce, seafood, ocean trout, wallaby, prime venison, milk-fed lamb, organic berries, stone fruits and cheeses.



DAY 04, contin... After golf, private transfer to the airport.



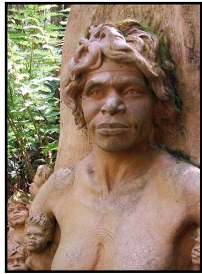

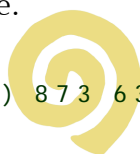

Evening: Dinner at leisure. Farewell Adelaide.

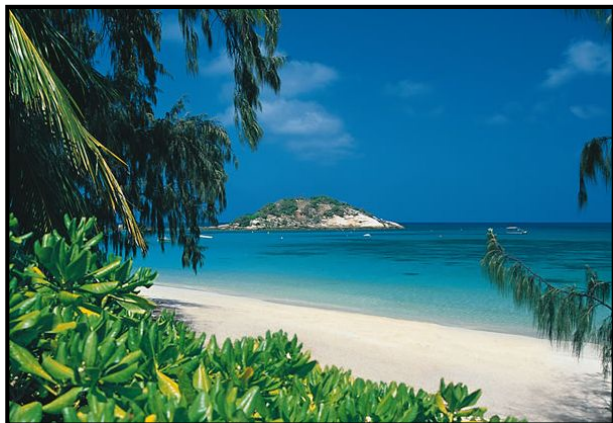
