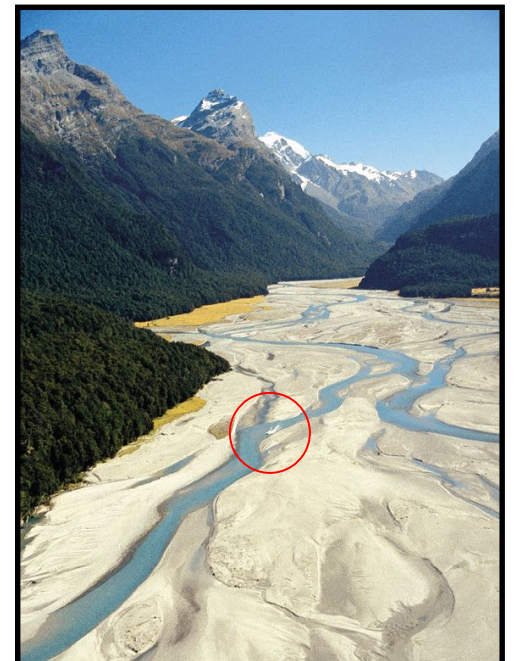
DAY 06

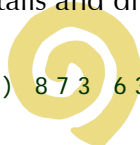

Evening: Cocktails and dinner at the Farm. The Hawke's Bay region is notable for serious food and splendid wines.

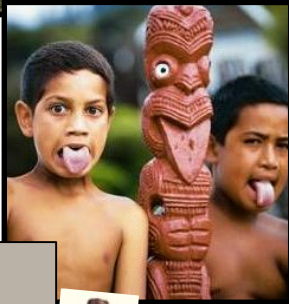


DAY 11

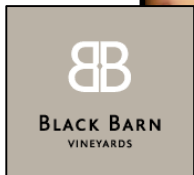
Lodge breakfast.

Tom Doak designed the course. The property is immense, with a sense of grandeur to everything and the views are out of this world. Five is a huge fairway is divided by two deep fairway bunkers. Then there's Al's Ace...The shortest hole on the course, but big numbers lurk all around this green, which is easy to reach but hard to stay on.



Non golfers, investigate local Maori culture and arts, the essence of Aotearoa's past and present. Journey to a *marae* and immerse yourself in art, lore and heritage. Or...tour the vineyards. Whites, reds, late harvest, bubbles...Olive oil is pressed nearby; the ice cream is huge here, too. Something for everyone!



Craggy Range is a spectacular on the banks of the Tukituki River, reminiscent of South Africa's Stellenbosch. NZ is well at the fore of the world's vine-dining revolution and CR's restaurant, Terrôir, grabbed the giant honor of "Top 13 Winery Restaurants in the World" in 2004.

Thermal wonderland...Opt for a private heli tour to White Island, an active volcano. Land on the Island, tour past steaming fumaroles and bubbling activity to the edge of the crater lake. Return via Mokoia Island, home to rare native birds. Pure North Island!

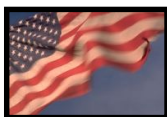
